

NFM 2026 Prizepool Prize Draw – Full Terms and Conditions

1. The Promoter

The promoter is National Football Museum, located at Urbis Building, Cathedral Gardens, Manchester, M4 3BG

2. Eligibility

- 2.1. The prize draw is open to all residents of the United Kingdom aged 18 years or over.
- 2.2. By entering on this website, you confirm that you meet these eligibility requirements and agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.

3. Entry Period and How to Enter

- 3.1. The prize draw is completely free to enter. No purchase, payment, or monetisation of any kind is required.
- 3.2. To enter, users must successfully register at nationalfootballmuseum.com/nfm2026prizepool.
- 3.3. Only one account and entry is permitted per person. Multiple entries using different email addresses will result in disqualification.
- 3.4. Entries open on 10 June 2026

4. Random Team Allocation

- 4.1. Upon successful sign-up, the website's automated, secure computer algorithm will instantly assign the user one team at random.
- 4.2. Users cannot choose, request, swap, or transfer their allocated team.
- 4.3. Because sign-up is open to an unlimited number of participants, multiple users will inevitably be assigned the same team. Every user is given an equal, unweighted chance of receiving any tournament team.

5. Qualification for the Prize Draw

- 5.1. All entrants automatically receive a sign-up gift, delivered as a discount code for year-long Museum entry.
- 5.2. Additional prize draws are based on tournament progression of the user's allocated team.
- 5.3. Semi-Final Prize Draw:
 - All users whose allocated team reaches the semi-final stage will be entered into a prize draw.

- One individual will be selected at random from the combined pool of users holding the three losing semi-finalist teams.
- 3 winners will be selected and will receive 1 × Loot Bag.

5.4. Final Prize Draw:

- All users whose allocated team wins the tournament will be entered into a prize draw.
- One individual will be selected at random from this pool.
- This winner will receive free tickets to the National Football Museum.

6. The Prize

- 6.1. Sign-up gift: discounted year-long Museum entry (via discount code).
- 6.2. Semi-final prize: 1 × Loot Bag (three winners only).
- 6.3. Final prize: free Museum tickets (one winner only).
- 6.4. Prizes are non-transferable, non-exchangeable, and no cash alternative is offered.
- 6.5. The Promoter reserves the right to replace the prize with an alternative of equal or higher value if circumstances beyond their control make it necessary to do so.

7. Winner Selection and Notification

- 7.1. Two winners will be selected at random from the pool of qualifying entries. This draw will be conducted via a verifiable computer process within 7 days of the final match.
- 7.2. The winners will be notified via the email address provided during registration within 3 days of the draw.
- 7.3. If a winner does not respond to the notification email within 14 days, they will forfeit the prize. The Promoter reserves the right to run a new random draw to select an alternative winner from the remaining qualifying pool.

8. Publicity and Data Protection

- 8.1. To comply with the UK Code of Non-broadcast Advertising, Sales Promotion and Direct Marketing (CAP Code), the Promoter must publish or make available the surname of the prize winner.

- 8.2. The winners have the right to object to this publication, by notifying the Promoter at the time of claiming their prize. Notwithstanding this, the Promoter is still legally required to provide this winner information to the Advertising Standards Authority (ASA) upon their request.
- 8.3. Any personal data collected during registration will be used solely for the administration of this competition and will not be shared with third parties or used for marketing unless explicit consent is given. All data will be deleted within 12 months of the prize being successfully awarded.

9. General Liability

- 9.1. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for entries not successfully completed due to a technical fault, website crash, server failure, or network disruption.
- 9.2. Insofar as is permitted by law, the Promoter will not be responsible or liable to compensate the winner or accept any liability for any loss, damage, or personal injury occurring as a result of taking up the prize.
- 9.3. These Terms and Conditions are governed by English law, and the parties submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of the United Kingdom.
